Dear Neythri Community,

At the conclusion of this year, we are sharing our 2024 Year in Review with you. This is an opportunity for us to reflect on the past year, and to celebrate how the work we do at Neythri has enabled our community to stay connected, learn, give back and grow.

2024 was a year of continued momentum for Neythri. There are increasingly more organizations focused on uplifting and elevating women professionally, and we are excited that this is so. Within that broader set, Neythri represents a significant opportunity for South Asian women specifically to come together and elevate each other. We are especially proud of the incredible community of senior leaders comprising our growing Founding and Leadership Circle.

We have heard wonderful stories from our members on what happens when they connect across our Neythri community. Women who report new professional roles coming from relationships built at Neythri. Women who get mentored on successfully negotiating their career journeys. Women who attribute their board of directors seats to their learning about how to be "board ready". As one member said, "Neythri is the golf course we never had".

Our 30+ programs and events this year have focused on fostering deeper connections and learning among the senior women leaders in our Leadership Circle, as well as for the membership at large.

A few key events and programs include:

- Neythri's inaugural Gala & Summit "The Nth Power: Leading Without Limits", a sold-out gathering of over 200 South Asian women
- Leadership development events like "Use Your Personal Brand to Achieve Your Next Goal"
- Panels and workshops, like "Business Model Reinvention with AI"
- Leadership Circle Mix & Mingles that help our senior members connect

- Our Salon program continues to be one of our most acclaimed initiatives, providing a "personal board of directors"
- Our Board Readiness program completed its seventh cohort, with a growing number of board appointments in the community
- Our Young Professionals pilot launched this year to enable aspiring leaders to connect with others in the community
- The Neythri Advisor Network comprises 100+ senior members offering expertise to each other
- Industry/functional roundtables (Boards, Go-to-Market, Healthcare and Social Impact), enable members in each space to engage
- Neythri Futures Fund has closed 24 investments since inception in companies featuring diverse & women-led teams. The fund also celebrated 3 exits to date.

Our global membership has grown steadily in the past five years, with 3,300+ members. We consistently hold events for our entire community to meet and network in our "Cocktails & Connections" format, and to learn from experts on a wide series of topics.

We continue to demonstrate what we can achieve when we work and think as a community with shared interests and mission. We hope that 2025 will see even more members connect with each other in person and beyond. As one member memorably said, "Neythri feels like home." We hope this will be true for so many more in the coming years!



Board Readiness & Board Connections

Our <u>Board Readiness program</u> is designed to help experienced South Asian female executives understand board service and develop a game-plan to activate their board journey. Currently offered to Neythri Founding Circle & Leadership Circle members only.

160+ senior executives have graduated from Neythri's 4-session Board Readiness Program, with seven cohorts since launch in 2021

Program elements include:

- Helping participants build their Board value proposition and synthesize the types of Boards they want to serve on
- Creating Board documents, polishing the elevator pitch, building the network gameplan, learning about Board due diligence, preparing for interviews and much more

In 2022, we launched our Board Connections initiative, with ongoing outreach to those who place diverse talents on boards, to build awareness about our community of board-ready women. Our board connections partners include top retained search firms, private equity and venture firms, organizations focused on increased board diversity such as HimforHer, Equilar, BoardList and Diligent. We created and launched a Board candidate database with profiles for each candidate which is shared with all partners, and we have seen much interest in our community.

While the journey to serving on a board takes time, we have begun to see signs of success in the past year+ among our members, for example:

Neythri Salons

Goal: to build multi-dimensional, rewarding connections with women from shared backgrounds

- Each <u>Neythri Salon</u> is a curated group of 8-12 senior South Asian women across industry sectors and functional areas that engage in intimate, thoughtprovoking, and fun get-togethers, virtually and/or in-person
- By sharing perspectives and telling authentic stories, these evenings of conversation become a source of deep connections. The agenda is set by the group some examples include:
 - How do you define success? How has this changed over your career?
 - The power of tradition: How has it shaped who you are?
 - Small habits can lead to meaningful positive changes in our lives. What are your life hacks?

We have a total of 17 salons with 180+ executives participating!

We are proud to share that we have 25 amazing leaders and rising stars participating in the program in San Francisco and New York City!





The Neythri Futures Fund I (NFF) is a historic first \$10M venture fund whose mission is to position South Asian women front and center as key investors and stakeholders in the fund.

- 100% of our investments are in companies with diverse founding/leadership teams
- 60% Female founders -> 63% of which are South Asian women
- 24 Investments to date, including two follow-on investments in AiFi and Vendia.


