We also took the bold but cautious step of hosting a few in-person get-togethers so we could all finally put a real face to the virtual ones and also saw numerous smaller meetups amongst our members. We continue to demonstrate what we can achieve when we work and think as a community with shared interests, even when we can't be together physically as often as we would like. Meanwhile, we have stayed our busiest best, launching new programs and initiatives as well as managing a broad array of our existing programs - our acclaimed Board Readiness program and the very popular Neythri Salon for Leadership Circle members continue to grow and thrive. We are stoked by the success of our newly launched Superpeer program thanks to which several Premier, Leadership and Founding Circle members have had the opportunity to speak with seasoned industry professionals, expand personal & professional networks and discover different perspectives.

This event drew more than 125+ Founding & Leadership Circle members from all over the country. The high-energy meetup where food and fun flowed in equal measure was enjoyed immensely by everyone that joined.

These and several other milestones could not have been possible without the collective efforts, commitment, and passion of our Founding Circle members, our team of volunteers, and our members. We are proud of all we have accomplished and want to thank you all for being a part of the Neythri journey. Your support, ambassadorship, and collective strength is what makes us formidable as a community. Board Readiness & Board Connections

Our Board Readiness program is designed to help experienced South Asian female executives understand board service and develop a gameplan to activate their board journey. Currently offered to Neythri Founding Circle & Leadership Circle members only

100+ senior executives have graduated from Neythri's 4-session Board Readiness Program, with five cohorts since launch in 2021

Program elements include:

- Helping participants build their Board value proposition and synthesize the types of Boards they want to serve on
- Create Board documents, polish their elevator pitch, build their network game-plan, learn about Board due diligence, prepare for interviews and much more

In 2022, we launched our Board Connections initiative, with ongoing outreach to those who place diverse talents on boards, to build awareness about our community of board-ready women

- Our board connections partners include top retained search firms, private equity and venture firms, organizations focused on increased board diversity such as HimforHer, Equilar, BoardList and Diligent
- We created and launched a Board candidate database with profiles for each candidate which is shared with all partners



Neythri Salons

Goal: to build multi-dimensional, rewarding connections with women from shared backgrounds

- Each Neythri Salon is a curated group of 8-10 senior South Asian women across industry sectors and functional areas that engage in intimate, thought-provoking, and fun get-togethers, virtually and/or inperson
- By sharing perspectives and telling authentic stories, these evenings of conversation become a source of deep connections. The agenda is set by the group some examples include:
 - How do you think about your personal brand?
 - What does it mean to be a woman of color in the workplace? Is this
 different for South Asians vs. others of color?
 - Do you need a validation fix? How do you get beyond this as you get more senior?

Launched a total of 17 (6 new in 2022) salons with 140+ executives participating!

Core to Neythri's mission is enabling our members to foster meaningful connections with each other. That's why we launched Superpeer, a booking platform where Neythri's Premier, Leadership, and Founding Circle members can book 30 minute 1:1 video calls with the experts, influencers, and professionals across multiple industries in the Neythri community. Members can ask questions, get a second opinion or advice, or just have an inspiring conversation.

Superpeers are Founding & Leadership Circle members who have walked the path, have a skill to teach, a passion or experience to share, and a desire to support professional development in the Neythri community. Examples of our Superpeers include Radha Sankaran (VP-CTO, CapitalOne), Radhika Krishnan (Chief Product Officer, Hitachi Vantara), Jagadha Sivan (COO, Waverley Street Foundation), and Zeryn Sarpangal (CFO, Draper Richards Kaplan Foundation).

- 100+ calls completed in 6 months
- 50+ hours of conversation and connection
- Superpeers represent 14 functional areas, ranging from engineering to go-to-market to operations to brand and more
- 33% of Superpeers are in the C-Suite
- 40% of Superpeers are on Boards





Neythri Futures Fund

The Neythri Futures Fund I (NFF) is a historic-first \$10M venture fund whose mission is to position South Asian women front and center as key investors and stakeholders in the fund.

- \$8M Investable (\$10M minus management fees)
- Fund Allocation
 - Primary Investments: \$5M \$6M
 - Follow-on reserves: \$2M \$3M
- Approximately \$4M deployed across 20 investments
- Min check size: \$20K; Max check size: \$500K; Avg check size ~\$180K
- 100% of our investments are in companies with diverse founding/leadership teams
 - 60% Female founders -> 63% of which are South Asian women
